The Curriculum

Rimbey Christian School, as a fully accredited school, follows the Alberta Provincial Program of Studies. Teachers with Alberta certification present the curriculum from a Christian perspective in which God is acknowledged as the creator and sustainer of the world and in which

students are challenged to relate their learning to their faith commitments.

Field trips, buddy programs and chapel assemblies all enhance student learning and develop a spirit of community. Our low student to teacher ratio facilitates greater individual attention.

The school welcomes students with special needs and makes every possible attempt to develop appropriate programs for them.

Our History

In 1986, 25 students were welcomed through the doors of Rimbey Christian School for the first time. These doors were attached to ATCO trailers which served as our school building for the first 3 years. Our present building was constructed on 8 acres within the town of Rimbey in 1989 and has since been expanded to include 9 classrooms, a library and computer lab.

Currently the school enrolment encompasses 84 students with a staff of 7 teachers, 7 classroom aides, a librarian, a music teacher and many parent volunteers.

WHAT IS A TUITION ASSISTANCE PROGRAM?

There are financial obligations when a family sends their child to an independent or private, non-public school. The primary expense is tuition; payments which go to support the cost of teachers, supplies and facilities. Rimbey Christian School is committed to a strong tuition assistance program. The School seeks students whose families are committed to using their own resources to make education their top priority. We expect that each family will stretch their financial resources and contribute a fair portion of the cost of education at the school. We will act as partners with your family to find the resources that will allow you to enroll your child.

HOW THE PROGRAM WORKS

Families whose current financial circumstances may not support the payment of the various fees required to attend the School may make an application for tuition assistance under the School's Tuition Assistance Program.

1. The Student must have made application for enrollment in Rimbey Christian School.
2. The family must be able to demonstrate the financial need for tuition assistance.

3. The application and corresponding documentation must be supplied to the School.
4. A letter outlining the need for tuition assistance, the duration of time tuition assistance may be required for, the conditions under which the applicant would no longer require some or all of the tuition assistance provided and the conditions under which the applicant may be able to repay some or all of the tuition assistance received, must accompany the application

LEVELS OF ASSISTANCE

There are two levels of Tuition Assistance available to families who qualify. They are:

- 50% of annual tuition fees
- 100% of annual tuition fees

HOW TO APPLY

Please ask Lorilee at the school for the person to call to receive an application package.

All applications are treated as confidential and are administered by an outside agency for qualification.

You will be notified of the results of your application within two weeks of submission. This is a confidential process that ensures the privacy of both the applicant and the recipient of tuition assistance.

WHAT WILL BE REQUIRED FROM YOU

For families who wish to apply under the School's Tuition Assistance Program, the following documents will need to be furnished to the School's Administration:

- Application Form
- Personal Net Worth Statement
- Income and expense statement
- Letter outlining the need for assistance
